


The **6** main sectors of the Port



The Port's missions



Develop maritime transport and promote the modal shift from road traffic to rail.

Manage nautical and land access, along with infrastructure access.

Facilitate the logistics of exported and imported goods.

Support the ecological transition in collaboration with port companies and local authorities.



With a traffic of **8,595,205 tons**, Port Atlantique La Rochelle ranks as the **6th largest French port**. Its **24/7 deep-water maritime access** and its infrastructure enable the Port to handle a versatile and diversified traffic of goods.
